About 30 senior residents were present when Morgan County officials broke ground for a new Somerville Senior Citizen Center on Wednesday. A couple of the seniors in the photograph joined County Commission Chairman Ray Long and District 2 Commissioner Randy Vest to help with the groundbreaking task. Vest says his county shop employees will prepare the site before E-Tech Construction Co. begins the work. Vest is hoping the center, which will cost about \$258,000, will be completed by fall.

“The time it takes to complete the construction will be heavily driven by the weather as in any construction project,” Vest said. I’m shooting for October, but you can’t say exactly because of the potential weather delays.”

The new center will be across from Somerville Courthouse on Main Street.
